Tour Conditions

TOUR DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT: Reservations are accepted with personal and bank checks and major credit cards.

ARRANGEMENTS: The tour price is based on the current rate of exchange, tariff rates, and air fares, in effect at time of registration. In the event of a marked increase in foreign currency, in air tariff, or in hotel or transportation rates, notifications will be sent to tour members in writing no later than 30 days prior to departure.

TRIP CANCELLATION: TRAVEL PROTECTION PLAN: You will be given the opportunity to purchase travel protection coverage for cancellations due to illness or accident. In the event you elect not to purchase the trip cancellations and you cancel the tour, charges will be made without exception in accordance with the Cancellation Policy.

CANCELLATION: \$100 per person penalty fee will be levied upon receipt of written cancellation notification received 100 days from the departure date. After that date the following will apply to cover the considerable penalties of the different suppliers: \$500 penalty with written cancellation notification 99–61 days before the departure date. 50% penalty with written cancellation notification 60–31 days before the departure date. 100% penalty with written cancellation notification within 30 days before the departure date.

AIRLINE MILEAGE PROGRAM: Eskin Tours' programs are based on specially negotiated group air fares with international and domestic airlines. Part of the negotiations is that our programs may not qualify for airline mileage programs. We do not offer assistance to group members in obtaining mileage credits and any application for mileage credits must be directed to the airline involved. Once you receive your passenger copy of the airline ticket at the end of each tour, it's solely your responsibility to save that copy as well as your boarding passes until you receive your mileage credit.

INTERNATIONAL AIRLINE TRAVEL: One piece of checked luggage is allowed on the tour. Its combined total measurement (length + width + height) cannot exceed 62 inches. You are also allowed one carry-on per person which must be able to fit under the seat in front of you with a total measurement of 45 inches. All special requests that we receive for particular seating arrangements (which must be noted on your reservation form as you sight up for the tour) are forwarded to the airlines involved. However, we regret in this time of mass travel and computerized seating reservations, we cannot guarantee or be responsible in the event that your request is not honored by the airline. (When checking in for your flight, please re-request your special seating arrangements with the ticket agent.) Should you wish to deviate from the package tour by changing your departure and/or return dates of travel, there will be a service charge of \$100 per person plus the additional cost of the change in air fare.

RESPONSIBILITY: Eskin Tours of 425 Huehl Rd., Unit 16A, Northbrook, IL 60062, and/or any travel agency and/or supplier of services pursuant to or in connection with this itinerary shall not be responsible or become liable for any delay incurred by any person in connection with any means of transportation, nor for any loss, damage, or injury to any person or property by reason of any event beyond the control of any agency, or supplier, or occurring without the fault or negligence of such agency or supplier. The right is reserved to substitute the airline to be used; the type of aircraft; and to alter the dates of the tour; the tour routing; or to cancel the trip if the minimum number of bookings is not reached for either the land or air portion of this itinerary. The right is also reserved to substitute hotels for other hotels in same category. Further, the right is reserved to decline to accept or cancel any tour. The right is also reserved to accept or refuse to accept any tour member. No refund will be made for voluntary absence from the tour unless arrangements are made at the time of booking. GENERAL LIMITATIONS AND EXCLUSIONS

Plan benefits are not payable for any loss due to, arising or resulting from: 1. suicide, attempted suicide or any intentionally self-inflicted injury of You, a Traveling Companion, Family Member or Business Partner booked to travel with You, while sane or insane; 2. an act of declared or undeclared war; 3. participating in maneuvers or training exercises of an armed service, except while participating in weekend or summer training for the reserve forces of the United States, including the National Guard; 4. riding or driving in races, or speed or endurance competitions or events; 5. mountaineering (engaging in the sport of scaling mountains generally requiring the use of picks, ropes, or other special equipment); 6. participating as a member of a team in an organized sporting competition; 7. participating in bodily contact sports, skydiving or parachuting, hang gliding or bungee cord jumping; 8. piloting or learning to pilot or acting as a member of the crew of any aircraft; 9. being Intoxicated, or under the influence of any controlled substance unless as administered or prescribed by a Legally Qualified Physician; 10. the commission of or attempt to commit a felony or being engaged in an illegal occupation; 11. normal childbirth or pregnancy (except Complications of Pregnancy) or voluntarily induced abortion; 12. dental treatment (except as coverage is otherwise specifically provided); 13. amounts which exceed the Maximum Benefit Amount for each coverage as shown in the Schedule of Benefits; 14. due to a Pre-Existing Condition, as defined in the Policy. The Pre-Existing Condition Limitation does not apply to the Emergency Medical Evacuation or return of remains coverage; 15. medical treatment during or arising from a Trip undertaken for the purpose or intent of securing medical treatment; 16. a mental or nervous condition, unless hospitalized for that condition while the Policy is in effect for You; 17. due to loss or damage (including death or injury) and any associated cost or expense resulting directly from the discharge, explosion or use of any device, weapon or material employing or involving chemical, biological, radiological or similar agents, whether in time of peace or war, and regardless of who commits the act and regardless of any other sequence thereof.

The following limitation applies to Trip Cancellation: All cancellations must be reported to the Travel Supplier within 72 hours of the event causing the need to cancel. If the event delays the reporting of the cancellation beyond the 72 hours, the event should be reported as soon as possible. All other delays of reporting beyond 72 hours will result in reduced benefit payments.

Additional Limitations and Exclusions Specific to Baggage and Personal Effects: Benefits are not payable for any loss caused by or resulting from: breakage of brittle or fragile articles; wear and tear or gradual deterioration; confiscation or appropriation by order of any government or custom's rule; theft or pilferage while left in any unlocked vehicle; property illegally acquired, kept, stored or transported; your negligent acts or omissions; property shipped as freight or shipped prior to the scheduled departure date; or electrical current, including electric arcing that damages or destroys electrical devices or appliances.
