The Liberal World Order

While on a recent trip to Japan, President Joe Biden said that America is “going through an incredible transition” to “be less reliant on fossil fuels.” Following Biden’s remarks, White House economic adviser Brian Deese suggested high prices and pain at the pump was the price Americans had to pay for the “future of the liberal world order.”

I don’t know about you, but the “liberal world order” is killing my wallet. According to the US Department of Agriculture, a family of four on a thrifty food plan will pay \$917 for groceries per month, up about 65% from a year ago. Gasoline prices have jumped over 53% from \$2.46 a gallon when Biden first took office to over \$5 a gallon. In Mendocino, California, you will pay a whopping \$10 per gallon. I’m not sure if Americans can afford to continue this “transition.”

Mysterious Fires

While prices continue to rise, fires have destroyed many of America’s food processing plants. The latest fires are part of a trend that began last year. As of this writing, more than a hundred United States food processing plants have been destroyed, damaged, or impacted by “accidental fires,” disease, or other causes. Here are just a few examples:

- 1/11/21 A fire destroyed a 75,000-square-foot processing plant in Fayetteville, NC
- 4/30/21 A fire ignited inside the Smithfield Foods pork processing plant in Monmouth, IL
- 7/25/21 Three-alarm fire at Kellogg plant in Memphis, TN
- 7/30/21 Firefighters battled a large fire at Tyson’s Ingredients plant in Hanceville, AL
- 8/23/21 Fire crews were called to the Patak Meat Production company in Austell, GA
- 9/13/21 A fire at the JBS beef plant in Grand Island, NE, forced a halt to production
- 10/13/21 A five-alarm fire ripped through the Darigold butter production plant in Caldwell, ID
- 11/15/21 A woman allegedly started a fire at the Garrard County Food Pantry in Lancaster, KY
- 11/29/21 A fire broke out at the Maid-Rite Steak Company meat processing plant in Dunmore, PA
- 12/13/21 West Side food processing plant in San Antonio, TX, was damaged after a fire
- 1/13/22 Firefighters battled a fire out at the Cargill-Nutrena plant in Lecompte, LA
- 1/31/22 a fertilizer plant caught on fire on Cherry Street in Winston-Salem, NC
- 2/3/22 A massive fire swept through Wisconsin River Meats in Mauston, WI
- 2/3/22 At least 130 cows were killed in a fire at Percy Farm in Stowe, VT
- 2/15/22 Bonanza Meat Company went up in flames in El Paso, TX
- 2/15/22 A fire destroyed most of the Shearer’s Foods plant in Hermiston, OR
- 2/16/22 A fire damaged America’s largest soybean processing and biodiesel plant in Claypool, IN
- 2/18/22 An early morning fire tore through the milk parlor at Bess View Farm in St. Albans, VT
- 2/19/22 An ammonia leak caused a shutdown at Lincoln Premium Poultry in Fremont, NE
- 2/22/22 The Shearer’s Foods plant in Hermiston, OR, caught fire again after a boiler exploded
- 2/28/22 A fire raged out of control at Nutrien Ag Solutions in Sunnyside, WA
- 2/28/22 A man was hurt during a fire at the Dutch Girl Creamery in Lincoln, NE
- 3/16/22 A fire damaged a Walmart warehouse distribution center in Plainfield, IN

- 3/16/22 Nestle Food Plant was extensively damaged in a fire in Jonesboro, AR
- 3/24/22 A major fire damaged the McCrum potato processing facility in Belfast, ME
- 3/29/22 A massive fire burned 40,000 pounds of food in storage near Maricopa, AZ
- 3/31/22 A structure fire damaged a key fresh onion packing facility in south Texas
- 4/13/22 Fire destroyed East Conway Beef & Pork Meat Market in Conway, NH
- 4/13/22 A plane crashed into Gem State Processing potato processing plant in Heyburn, ID
- 4/14/22 Taylor Farms Food Processing plant burned down Salinas, CA
- 4/19/22 Azure Standard food processing in Dufur, OR, was destroyed by fire
- 4/21/22 A small plane crashed at a General Mills plant in Covington, GA
- 5/19/22 A train carrying fertilizer derailed at Jensen Beach, FL
- 5/29/22 A fire destroyed a poultry building at Forsman Farms in Howard Lake, MN
- 6/7/22 A fire damaged the JBS meat packing plant in Green Bay, WI
- 6/8/22 A fire gutted the Purina Feed Mill in Arcola, LA
- 6/9/22 Irrigation water was canceled in California (the #1 producer of food in the US) and storage water flushed directly out to the delta
- 6/12/22 The largest pork company in the US shut down a California plant due to high costs
- 6/13/22 Fire broke out at a processing plant west of Waupaca County in Belmont, WI
- 6/14/22 Over 10,000 head of cattle died in the Kansas heat wave
- 6/23/22 George's Inc. Poultry closed its food processing plant in Campbell County, TN
- 1/1/2021-6/30/22 In addition to the fires, almost 50 million chickens, 3 million turkeys, and a half million ducks have been destroyed due to disease

Are we supposed to believe that what we are witnessing is just one “tragic accident” after another? We aren’t supposed to see any sort of a pattern, and we aren’t supposed to ask any questions. People sure are getting careless these days, because “accidents” just keep happening time after time after time. I’m starting to think the “liberal world order” means America will have empty grocery store shelves.

Missing Food

All of this is taking place at a moment in history when we are being told we are about to enter an absolutely horrifying global food crisis. During recent testimony in front of the UN Security Council, the CEO of Gro Intelligence warned that “the lowest grain inventory levels the world has ever seen” are getting even lower. Sara Menker said, “It is important to note that the lowest grain inventory levels the world has ever seen are now occurring while access to fertilizers is highly constrained. And drought in wheat growing regions around the world is the most extreme it’s been in over 20 years. Similar inventory concerns also apply to corn and other grains.” In other words, there isn’t going to be enough food for everyone.

My intention in writing this article was not to scare you, but to prepare you. I am not saying you should be a “prepper” and stock ten thousand cans of SPAM in your basement. But unless (in the words of Hank Williams Jr.) you can “skin a buck and run a trotline,” maybe it wouldn’t be a bad idea to pick up an extra can of beans or two... The Bible reminds us:

Go to the ant, thou sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise: Which having no guide, overseer, or ruler, Provideth her meat in the summer, and gathereth her food in the harvest.

—Proverbs 6:6-8

Malnourished Future

While these events may or may not plunge the world into a worldwide famine soon, the Bible is clear - a global famine will strike the world during the Tribulation. The Bible describes this famine in detail (Revelation 6:5-6). Riding on a black horse and holding a pair of scales, Revelation 6 says a voice calls out, “A measure of wheat for a penny, and three measures of barley for a penny; and see thou hurt not the oil and the wine.” The rider’s scales suggest a need to carefully measure and ration the food supply. Three measures of barley equal about one pint which is the minimum amount of food needed to survive. This verse is telling us a time is coming when an entire day’s wages will only buy enough food to survive.

When this happens, it is possible the Genesis story of Joseph and Pharaoh will play out a second time. Desperate for food, most of the world will willingly give their wealth and power to anyone who can feed them. Just as in ancient Egypt, when the dust finally settles, one man will control everything. That man is the final world ruler – the Antichrist.

The signs of the times are all around us. Jesus is coming soon. Are you ready?

Roe v. Wade Aftermath—Lessons From the Ongoing War

The overturning of *Roe v. Wade* has been a great victory for life. Several jurists agree, *Roe v. Wade* was “bad law.” It was about time for a change. However, while pro-lifers celebrated, abortion terrorists have fire-bombed pro-life organizations and churches standing for life. The group Ruth Sent Us published the home addresses of six Supreme Court justices leading to front-yard protests and threats against the justices and their families.

Ruth Sent Us suggested targeting the children of Supreme Court Justice Amy Coney Barrett. The group tweeted an infographic with the name of Barrett’s church. It also identified the school that Barrett’s children attend, and encouraged protesters to “voice your anger” by demonstrating there.

With a strong but unsuccessful attempt at gaining the moral high ground, Ruth Sent Us announced, “Our 6–3 extremist Supreme Court routinely issues rulings that hurt women, racial minorities, LGBTQ+ and immigrant rights. We must rise up to force accountability using a diversity of tactics.”

Jane’s Revenge, a coalition of pro-abortion groups, attacked pro-life pregnancy centers. On June 15, this group published its manifesto promising that the attacks will increase and stated they “find joy” in creating fear and mayhem. Each post of Jane’s Revenge clearly reveals the demented and satanic spirit driving such groups. A “Night of Rage” is being planned in which disgruntled abortion activists plan to “unleash hell.” “We need to express this madness fully and with ferocity. We need to quit containing ourselves. We need them to be afraid of us,” they announced.

As Matt Staver of Liberty Counsel wrote, “Roe’ May Be Dead, But Jezebel Is Still Alive and Well.” The biblical character Jezebel is perhaps the most twisted worshipper of Baal and other blood-thirsty deities. Baal worship was characterized by sexual deviancy and the sacrifice of children to satisfy the false deity’s thirst for the blood of innocents..

What It Means For America

The U.S. Supreme Court has delivered a landmark victory for the pro-life movement—but also an astounding victory for democracy in America. The high court’s ruling to overturn *Roe v. Wade* is a culmination of a long-fought, intensely emotional battle by the men and women who support the

sanctity of human life. Their years of labor and intense prayer have finally paid off.

Consequently the controversial issue of abortion has been taken out of the hands of nine unelected justices and placed in the hands of elected state officials. Abortion has not been outlawed, but it will now be decided at the state level where the people of individual states can express their desires in the polling place. This is the American way.

What It Means for the Christian Cause and Spiritual Warfare

The current controversy is not just about different opinions. It’s about the nature of every Christian’s struggle as articulated in Ephesians 6:12: “For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.” America is in the throes of spiritual warfare. The pro-abortion crowd has an insatiable appetite for doing harm and has the support of high-ranking government officials who seem motivated by the same demonic insanity.

Instead of condemning the senseless and destructive rage, President Biden has fueled the fires by blaming Trump’s pro-life court appointees and claiming that abortion is healthcare. Worse yet, in front of the Supreme Court, Senate Minority Leader Chuck Schumer joined pro-choice protesters on the day justices debated the constitutionality of a Louisiana pro-abortion legislation titled “Louisiana Unsafe Abortion Protection Act.” During his speech, Schumer yelled, “I want to tell you Neil Gorsuch, and you Brett Kavanaugh, you have unleashed a whirlwind, and you will pay the price. You won’t know what hit you if you go forward with these awful decisions.”

The court was hearing a challenge to a Louisiana law that required doctors who perform abortions to have admitting privileges at nearby hospitals, a law opponents said would limit women’s access to abortion in the state.

This is clearly a complex issue, but there are some basic principles that I want to make note of.

First, the overturning of *Roe v. Wade* is a great victory, but the war is by no means over. Multitudes of Christians and conservatives, both men and women, have been engaged in a hard, long-term effort, but the war is by no means over. We have not entered the Millennium. This is not the King-

dom Age.

If anything can be certain, it is this: Satan and his minions are angry and have not surrendered. Instead, the battle has been ramped up. The battle will intensify. Our nation has been in a moral free-fall for many years. This victory will not stop the free fall. The imps of hell will say, “We have been conquered, but we have not been convinced.”

The godless moral conditions that produced Planned Parenthood and the countless women who believe that abortion is a constitutional right are still with us. Those who believe that Satan is currently bound and we are in the Millennium of Revelation 20:1–6 may take momentary comfort in the overturning of *Roe v. Wade*, but Satan is still Satan, his agenda is as popular as ever, and the philosophy of human autonomy, in which man is seen as the master of his destiny, is still in the hearts of multitudes.

Second, the Biden presidency has been a disaster for ALL Americans, even for Democrats, but Biden is still their darling. Hostility against Christian conservatism is so hardened and irrational that it can be said, “The dog is turned to his own vomit again; and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire” (2 Pet. 2:22). There is really nothing attractive about vomit and mire, yet it has its supporters. Dogs and sows can be covered with the worst of slop but have the most contented looks on their face. They are not looking for something better. This is the best—and they love it.

Third, America is in travail for basically one reason: We have departed from our moral roots. The confusion and violence caused by overturning *Roe v. Wade*, and other serious social problems in America, like the terrible loss of life from the random shootings, are all symptomatic of America’s departure from our Christian roots.

While Joe Biden ran on the issue of “transgender rights” and marriage equality, the blessings of liberty will only be experienced in the context of a moral and virtuous society. There are no “transgender rights.” It is a made-up category to promote a radical, left-wing agenda. Furthermore, “same-sex marriage” is an oxymoron. Two same-sex individuals coming together in no way can be called “marriage.”

If America’s founders were able to view today’s news they would have to shake their heads in dismay. John Adams, signer of the Declaration of Independence and second president of the United States, said, “It is religion and morality alone which can establish the principles upon which freedom can securely stand. The only foundation of a free constitution is pure virtue.” Adams also stated, “We have no government armed with power capable of contending with human pas-

sions unbridled by morality and religion. . . . Our constitution was made only for a moral and religious people. It is wholly inadequate to the government of any other.”

And, of course, when the founders speak about “morality and religion” they are speaking of the morality and religion found in the Bible, which, unfortunately, has become the object of derision and scorn in modern academia. John Quincy Adams, sixth president of the United States, wrote: “There are three points of doctrine the belief of which form the foundation of all morality. The first is the existence of God; the second is the immortality of the human soul; and the third is a future state of rewards and punishments. Suppose it possible for a man to disbelieve either of these three articles of faith and that man will have no conscience, he will have no other law than that of the tiger and the shark. The laws of man may bind him in chains or may put him to death, but they never can make him wise, virtuous, or happy.”

Notice the words, “and that man will have no conscience.” Does this not describe so many of the shooting rampages of the summer of 2022? And does it not describe the bloodthirsty abortionists who slay the unborn by the thousands?

The Indoctrination of the American Mind

While many Americans miss what is going on, Lily Tang Williams, who is currently running as a Republican candidate for Congress in New Hampshire’s second district, discussed the lessons she learned as a witness to the brutality of the Chinese Cultural Revolution and shared a warning to Americans on the importance of fighting for liberty.

Tang Williams argues that children were one of the most effective tools Mao exploited to fuel his revolution. They became indoctrinated to a point where they betrayed their parents to the communist state in order to move upwards in Mao’s system.
